The management of the College, the Principal and the Heads of the departments plan the academic activities of the College. They take necessary steps to formulate and implement strategic plans of the institution. The Principal invite suggestions from all the stakeholders through various meetings & feedback system and accordingly takes steps to improve overall academic environment. The Heads of the departments monitor the system of each department regularly.

#### One example to be cited here is of 'Teaching Plan'.

Teaching plan is necessary to create and work from lesson plans, plans that keep student learning according to class timetable. We need to work from lesson plans as we know our topics to be covered, our teaching methods and also the evaluation process. It makes a teacher very structured. It controls free-flowing conversations and also the irrelevant discussions in a classroom. The well planned teaching plan directs the topics we are studying. However, students know what to expect each month and teacher is striving to be more structured in his/her class. Teaching plans can help teacher stuck to learning objectives/outcomes of the curriculum. The completion of each topic depends upon the ability of the student.

The teacher works methodically to achieve each objective set in the curriculum. Planning forces teachers to consider course outcomes and gives teachers systematic ways to engage students in course material. It also helps in assessment and evaluation of each topic.

The style of teaching plan implemented is perfectly fine to plan lessons. It includes the particular topic, the method used, and the assignment for the topic/course. Sometimes it also indicates the cocurricular activity in which students have to be engaged. It gives an opportunity to students' to connect with course material and the flexibility to use that material as per the directions. Our teachers are teaching in this manner and get a hold on students to engage them in classes.

All activities of the institute are planned and implemented strictly in accordance with the teaching plan and academic calendar.
